- 9. "Cluster" method. A topic is free and open to students who go to clusters is a pedagogical strategy that helps to think like this. Based on this method, define a new one elicitation is an effective way to add new ideas to existing knowledge.
- 10. "Insert" method. In this case, presenting a text or story to the students and from the students asking him to repeat it. When this method is created with text, activity, observation and a powerful method for supporting support.
